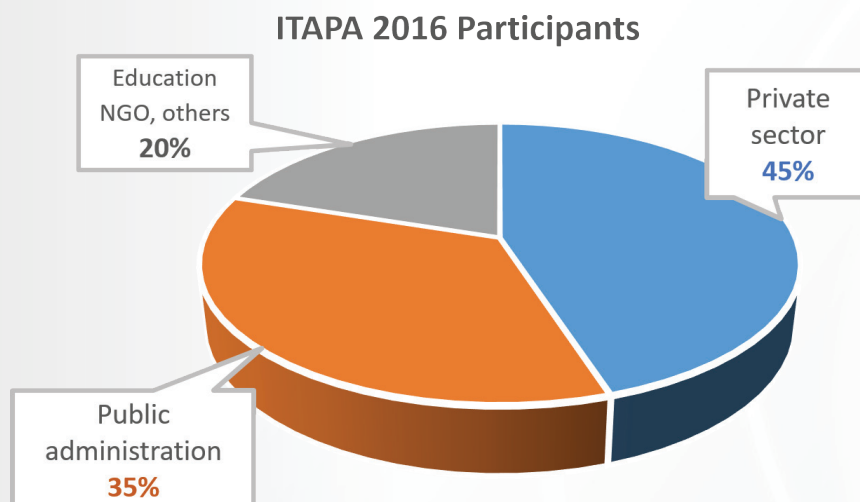
Information Technologies and Public Administration

16th ITAPA International Congress

The ITAPA events (Information Technologies and Public Administration) bring for already **16 years** new inspirations for the Slovak eGovernment. With more than a decade of their existence ITAPA events have become a top discussion platform for the entire IT community. Our events are regularly held under the auspices of top government representatives such as the Deputy Prime Minister, ministers or heads of various institutions.

ITAPA consists of two main events - **Spring Conference** which is a one-day event dedicated to local topics with strong discussion character and **autumn Congress**, a two-day international event aimed at encouragement and promotion of latest trends and solutions in the field of society digitization not only in Slovakia but around the world. The primary aim of ITAPA is to establish permanent open platform thanks to which all the key stakeholders from political and professional life have the opportunity to get together and discuss the most important issues in the area of public administration digitization. The added value of ITAPA events is also in a dozen of international insights that are brought to participants by inspirational national and foreign speakers followed by intense networking. Presentations about innovative projects, best practices, discussions on urgent eGov issues as well as dissemination of motivating ideas and solutions are seen not only by representatives of IT companies or political scene and eGov elite but also by representatives of the NGO sector, consulting companies and academic field. The most relevant IT companies in Slovakia have been key partners of the ITAPA since its start in 2002.

The number of Spring ITAPA visitors is approx. 300 and the autumn Congress will take up twice each year. Nearly 100 speakers from the whole world join more than 10 panel sessions, dozens of keynotes and open discussions. All Congress presentations are translated to/from English.

In 2016 was for the third time announced the Radio Slovakia listeners awards. In this competition listeners of Radio Slovakia themselves can select winning projects. Thanks to this ITAPA-Radio Slovakia cooperation can be submitted solutions evaluated by ordinary citizens - the primary target group of these projects.

The ITAPA Distinction Awards ceremony takes place at the ITAPA Gala Dinner with the participation of Congress visitors and other invited VIP guests.
